Key features:

Details of publishing synthesized paper on our website:

- Students are expected to complete their synthesis within 10 weeks, followed by 2 weeks for editorial review.
- \$150 will be charged for publishing synthesized paper on our website.
- Charges include: 1) editing of 2 drafts and final version; 2) designing and placing cover; 3) printing 10 copies for students to keep; and 4) posting eReport on our website.
- Synthesized papers will be catalogued: 1) By ESG topic; 2) By title; 3) By author name; 4) By author's high school name; and 5) By published ESG books included in the synthesized paper (from our bookstore).
